

As we enter our 11th season of the Cathedral Concert Series, we are grateful to God for the gift of music, the provision of this series, and the opportunity to present internationally renowned artists in concerts of sacred music here in Birmingham, Alabama. Our 10th anniversary season welcomed VOCES8 back to the Advent, as well as guest soloists and a Baroque orchestra for the Cathedral Choir's complete performance of Handel's *Messiah*.

The 2024-2025 season has great things in store. First on the series will be a rare opportunity to hear the renowned choral group **The Sixteen** directed by Harry Christophers on Monday, October 21. The ensemble does not tour often, making this a truly special event. Acclaimed church musician, organist, improviser, and composer **Bruce Neswick** will be with us in the new year to lead the Cathedral Choir in a hymn festival on Sunday, February 16. **New York Polyphony** returns to perform at the Advent on Tuesday, April 29, having last performed here during the inaugural season of the series in 2013. Both Charles Kennedy and I will perform organ recitals on this year's series as well.

In October we have a special Choral Evensong that will be led by **Philip Moore**, Organist Emeritus of York Minster and a prolific composer who has written commissioned choral works for the Cathedral Choir.

I also want to thank you all for your interest and support, and for keeping a love of sacred music alive in the city of Birmingham.

Celebrating its 45th anniversary this year, The Sixteen arose from its Founder and Conductor Harry Christophers' formative experience as cathedral chorister and choral scholar. His enterprise, launched in 1979, built on the best of the British choral tradition while setting new standards of virtuosity and musicianship. The Sixteen's professional female and male voices create a distinctive sound of great warmth and clarity. Although refined over four decades, that sound has remained remarkably consistent, always responsive to the emotional content of words and music, ever alert to subtle nuances of color and shading. The UK-based ensemble, hallmarked by its tonal richness, expressive intensity, and compelling collective artistry, has introduced countless newcomers to works drawn from well over five centuries of sacred and secular repertoire. Critically acclaimed New York Polyphony is one of the foremost vocal chamber ensembles active today. Their innovative programming spans Gregorian chant to contemporary commissions, and their focus on familiar and rare works of the 12th-17th centuries has helped bring early music to modern audiences. Founded in 2006, the quartet's growing discography includes two GRAMMY-nominated albums, and many of their releases have topped the "best of" lists of major publications. Bruce Neswick enjoys immense popularity and is in tremendous demand throughout the country as organist, improviser, choral conductor and trainer, commissioned composer, and hymn festival leader. He is a musician whose playing vibrates with energy, is full of radiant color, and always expertly crafted. Mr. Neswick holds the Fellowship degree from the Royal School of Church Music and was awarded an honorary doctorate in 2016 by the University of the South, Sewanee, TN. He is the Artist-in-Residence at St. James by-the-Sea Episcopal Church in La Jolla, California. The Cathedral Church of the Advent is delighted to welcome him to lead us in what will be a thrilling hymn festival. Admission is free.
