



STEWARDSHIP CALLER TRAINING

Thank you for your willingness to serve as a Stewardship Caller for this year's Stewardship Campaign. The main responsibility of a Stewardship Caller is to follow up with fellow Adventers who have not turned in their Pledge Cards by the second Stewardship Sunday. You will receive your list of names, typically less than ten, on the Friday after the second Stewardship Sunday. Below we break down your responsibilities into three sections: what to do before, during, and after making your Stewardship calls.

BEFORE STEWARDSHIP CALLER WEEKS

PRAY

- For God to speak through you as you make your calls and to open the hearts of those whom you call.

PLEDGE

- Prayerfully decide about your gift to the Advent.
- Turn in your Pledge Card before we begin our work as Stewardship Callers so that you are not on a call list.

PREPARE

- Read and pray through the Adventers on your list.
- Familiarize yourself with the Guidance for Callers and Stewardship FAQ.

DURING STEWARDSHIP CALLER WEEKS

CALL

- Please do not procrastinate; begin making your calls immediately after receiving your list.
- It is very important that we stay on schedule.

CARE

- Please take the time to listen if someone needs to talk.
- If someone has questions you cannot answer or needs additional care, note this information on your Call Journal.

BE CREATIVE

- If there is no answer, leave a message.
- Follow up with an email or text message - these serve as reminders. Provide the link to the online Pledge Card (AdventBirmingham.org/Pledge).

AFTER STEWARDSHIP CALLER WEEKS

RECORD

- Record your calls as you go to help the office keep track of who has been contacted.
- Someone else will follow up with those who have not pledged.

REPLY

- Return your Call Journal to the office before the deadline, even if you have not completed all of your calls.
